Updates walks Lefkada on Foot 2022

Walk no. 1

Page 11: The 30km sign is no longer there.

Walk no. 2

Page 13: Unfortunately, the Kako Lagadi gorge is very poorly maintained and dangerous in some places. It is not recommended to walk into this gorge but to continue the walk on the top of page 14 from the ruins with the wooden bench.

Walk no. 3A

Page 16: Taverna de Rose no longer exists, now the restaurant is called Skaroi.

Page 17: Unfortunately, the Kako Lagadi gorge is very poorly maintained and dangerous in some places. It is not recommended to walk into this gorge and just continue the walk as if you had not entered the gorge.

Walk no. 3B

Page 20: See at 3A, page 17 and page 16

Walk no. 4

Page 22: The kiosk no longer exists.

Page 24: Unfortunately, the Kako Lagadi gorge is very poorly maintained and dangerous in some places. It is not recommended to walk into this gorge and just continue the walk as if you had not entered the gorge.

Walk no. 5

Page 26: The kiosk no longer exists. The monopati of SP6 (page 29) is partly well cleaned but the last part was quite overgrown in February 2022 but it was possible to walk on.

Walk no. 6

Page 31: The kiosk no longer exists.

Walk no. 6A

Page 34: At FH1 you go almost straight ahead towards the asphalt road where you keep right. This is the narrow asphalt road where the footpath at FH1 (now overgrown) ends.

Walk no. 7

Page 36: The yellow mailbox has been taken away.

Page 37: The path steep uphill KA3 is overgrown, better keep following the main road to get to the monastery.

Walk no. 9

Page 49: The path from EG3 is partially cemented due to access to the cemetery.

Walk no. 9A (7 km)

Page 93: A new part of the walk has been marked with red plus yellow stripes by the cultural association of Englouvi. In this way you avoid the tarmac road. When you stand with your back to the Ag. Donatos church, you will see the start of the path on the other side of the road slightly to the left. Follow the red/yellow marks. After about 3 ½ km you will reach the asphalt road, here slightly to the left and then follow the road to the right towards the church of Profitas Ilias for a while until you see a sign to go down. This walk descends via a path that leads to the asphalt road at Englouvi. Here you turn left, a little bit further at the shrine turn right and at the green gate turn sharp left and further down along the paved track you will come to where you started the walk.

Walk no. 11

The $\Pi PO\Sigma OXH$ sign is no longer there.

Walk no. 17,

Page 84: Marking with blue dot and arrow is gone.

Page 85: The dirt road is now paved and from here all the road is paved. You do not have to continue until the main asphalt road of Lefkada-Nydri. A bit earlier you will see the new Nikiana boutique apartment on the right, before this a gravel road turns to the left. Continue to follow this small road (sometimes concrete), keep right at 2 forks until you reach the road from the beginning of the walk after more than a kilometer (you come from the concrete road mentioned on p.83), turn right and after a 10-minute walk you will arrive from the starting point of the walk.

Walk no. 19,

Page 92: Several gates have come up on the footpath from Katochori to Fterno, easy to open except for the gate at the beginning of the footpath at the stable, this is a bit more difficult but it is possible.

Walk no. 22,

Page 107: At KO5 the field is fenced. Go left, keep following the fence to the right and soon you will see the ruins of the Ag. Sotiro. Back along the fence to the field road and then to the right.

Page 116: The track to the left is paved. You can also continue to follow the asphalt road and you will also arrive at the new church (VSA9).

Walk no. 23, 24

Page 112, 115: Traffic mirror is gone.

Page 114, 118: Corrugated iron shed has disappeared.

Page 114, 118: The bridge has been broken/disappeared. It is possible to descend, cross the riverbed (in winter and spring there may be water in it!) and clamber up again. However, it is easier to follow the main asphalt road, but a bit more boring.

Walk no. 26

Page 126: The path near the shrine was quite overgrown.

Walk no. 27

Page 130: The footpath at KE2 is worn out by the water, a little bit of a clamber but it is doable (about 15 minutes). At the end of this scramble, keep to the left between the vegetation (we have erected a wooden post), further on under the overhanging rock, the path bends to the right and at the top follow the field-track to the left.

Walk no. 28

Page 136: A short distance before KAL12 a wide path goes down to the left that ends at the Panaghia church.

Page 137: Construction activities have unfortunately started at KAL16.
